

Software

The software for adding or extracting information/files for the Motorola W385 is called Motorola Phone Tools. It is available free on CD at our office (16 Mill St. E, Milverton) or you can download the program on our website www.mornington.ca.

Connectivity

To access your W385 through Motorola Phone Tools you will need to connect your phone to your computer. There are two ways you can do this.

1) USB Cable - Mornington has 3 ft. Cables that connect your cell to your computer available at our office.

2) Blue Tooth - If your computer has Blue Tooth connectivity, then you can transfer files to and from your cell phone and computer.

When you first load Motorola Phone Tools you will be given your connectivity options on a screen.

Instruction Manual

This is just a brief run-through of some popular cell phone actions. A full Instruction booklet is included in the W385 box upon purchase.

Using Blue Tooth

- 1) On your phone, go to *data - settings - connection - Blue Tooth Link*.
- 2) Scroll down and click *Handsfree*
- 3) Click on your Blue Tooth device or click on [Look for Devices] to search for any devices in the area.

Using Voice Activation

- 1) Press the rectangular button on the right side of the W385.
- 2) First say what action you want to take (example: Call, Send Message, Look Up, Check, etc.)
- 3) Follow instructions from then on. (Example: if you decided to Call, then it will ask you who? Then you say the persons name. It will then ask for confirmation, say Yes. If the person has multiple numbers saved under one name it will ask you which one - you say home, cell or work and then that number will be dialed.
- 4) Voice activation settings can be changed in *menu - settings - personalize - voice dial setup*.

Adding an MP3 to your W385

- 1) Link cell phone to computer using USB cable or Blue Tooth connection
- 2) Open Motorola Phone Tools
- 3) Choose your profile
- 4) Click on *Multimedia Studio* on the menu on the right side
- 5) In the *Multimedia Studio*, Click on *File Transfer Studio* on the menu on the left side OR on the link in the middle of the page.
- 6) In the box on the left titled *My Computer*, browse your computers files until you find the specific MP3 you would like to load.
*Note: Only MP3 files will work.
- 7) Drag the MP3 file to the box on the right side titled *Mobile Phone* and into the folder titled *audio*.
- 8) The MP3 is now on your cell phone . It will be located in *menu - multimedia - audio*. Highlight and press the centre circle button on your phone to play.

Using MP3's as Ring Tones

- 1) In your cell phone, go to *menu - settings - ring styles - detail*.
- 2) Scroll down to *Calls*, press centre circle.
- 3) Scroll down to the MP3 you would like (it will be included in that list)
- 4) Press the centre circle to select ring.

Adding a picture to your W385

- 1) Follow steps 1-5 (from MP3 Capabilities)
- 2) In the box on the left titled *My Computer*, browse your computers files until you find the specific picture you would like to load.
- 3) Drag the file to the box on the right side and into the folder titled *pictures*.
- 4) The picture is now saved in the phone, to retrieve it in the phone go to *menu - multimedia - pictures*.

Taking a picture with your W385

- 1) In your phone, go to *menu - multimedia - camera*.
- 2) Use ^ v buttons to zoom in and out, and press the center circle to take the picture.

Editing a picture in your W385

- 1) Follow steps 1-4 (from MP3 Capabilities)
- 2) In the multimedia studio, click on *image studio* on the left side OR on the link in the middle of the page.
- 3) In the box on the left, browse through the pictures on your phone you would like to edit.
- 4) When you select the image, your selection will be displayed in the bottom box. From there, you can use the buttons on the top of that box to edit the picture by cropping, brightening, returning to regular size, etc. When done, click *transfer to phone*.

Adding a calendar event to your W385

- 1) Follow steps 1-2 (from MP3 Capabilities)
- 2) Click on *Calendar* on the menu on the right side.
- 3) In the box on the left titled *Outlook* (or whatever email system you use) browse your folders until you find *Calendar* and click that.
- 4) Your events are now displayed in the left box. Whatever event you would like on your phone, drag it to the box on the right titled *Mobile Phone*.
- 5) Your event is now in your phone. Access the *Calendar* by using *menu - tools - datebook*. Your phone will also alarm you of all reminders.

Adding contacts to your W385

- 1) Follow steps 1-2 (from MP3 Capabilities)
- 2) Click on *Contacts* on the menu on the right side.
- 3) In the box on the left titled *Outlook* (or whatever email system you use) browse folders until you find *Contacts* and click that.
- 4) Your contacts are now displayed in the left box. Whatever contact you would like on your phone, drag it to the box on the right titled *Mobile Phone*.
- 5) Your contacts you have selected will now be in your W385's phone book.
